We'll be capturing some of the day's joyful moments with photos (to be shared privately with families), so everyone can look back on the fun we had and on the School's social media platforms.

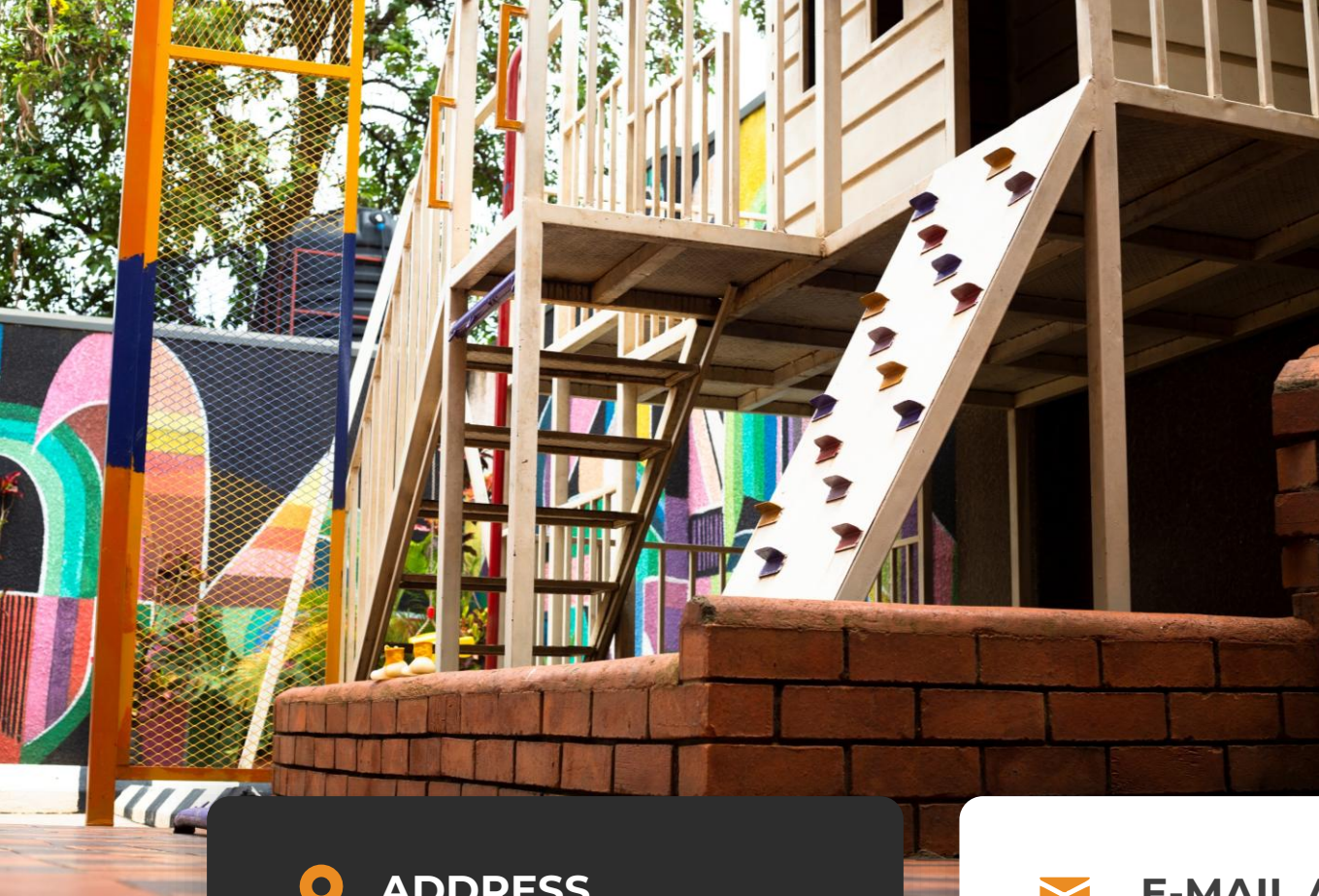


In Conclusion
